Miss Widdett is awfully nervous about missing her station, and keeps running to the door to make sure each stop corresponds to what the conductor says it is.


Pete, the train boy, looking over the territory. Anyhow, it "can't be no wise" than the car behind, where two five-cent bars of chocolate were the only sales.
