PREFACE.

THE primary object in view for collecting the materials of which this little work is composed, was to ascertain the number and names of the descendants of Jeremiah Guild—of the fifth generation, according to the plan adopted—who had two wives, seven sons, and seven daughters. By researches, and by the information obtained from a work entitled a "Genealogy of the Descendants of John Guild," by Calvin Guild, of Dedham, Mass., it is ascertained that the genealogy of this Jeremiah can be traced to this same John Guild, one of the original settlers in Dedham, and from whom the generations in this work are numbered. The chief design of this undertaking has been accomplished in collecting the names of more than five hundred descendants of one person, whose first child was born just one century ago this present year (1877). In addition to this, some steps have been taken toward obtaining a more complete genealogy of this branch of the Guild family.

HISTORY.

THE first record of the name of Guild in America appears to have been made in the town of Dedham, in Massachusetts, where two brothers and a sister (as is supposed), John, Samuel, and Ann, arrived from Scotland about the year 1636. The marriage of James Allen and Ann Guild is recorded in 1638, this being the only mention of them on record. Samuel was admitted a freeman in 1642, but did not long remain in Dedham. John Guild was admitted to the church in Dedham, July 17, 1640, and made a freeman in 1643. He was one of the original grantees of the town. He married, April 24, 1645, Elizabeth Crooke, of Roxbury. She transferred her relation from the church in Roxbury to the church in Dedham, July 4, 1649. Her death occurred August 31, 1669.

Little is known of his early youth, except that he lived with his mother, who, in 1754, was a widow, and the owner of eighteen acres of land in the Parish of Middle-

field, in Middletown, with the use of which, and the avails of her own labor (being a tailoress), she managed to support herself and her three children, until these became of sufficient age to support themselves. The death of her husband must have occurred at some period between the birth of Jeremiah and the above-named date. His death, it is said, was caused by a cancer when about forty years of age. His son, Jeremiah, being strongly inclined to a sea-faring life, engaged himself as a sailor on board of a vessel making voyages to the West Indies, carrying various productions of the colony to exchange for commodities produced there. At length, having studied navigation, and become the owner and captain of a sloop, he engaged in the same business on his own account. Sometime during the Revolutionary war his vessel was taken by the British and burned, he and his brother Samuel, who was one of his crew, being carried prisoners to Halifax, in Nova Scotia. After some time he was permitted to go home on parole, having signed a paper binding himself not to bear arms against His Majesty the King of Great Britain, during the war. After being released from imprisonment, he returned to Middlefield, and, having bought some land in addition to that which his mother owned, he engaged in farming, as the best business he could then pursue. Here he resided until his mother's death, which took place March 21, 1792, she being 78 years of age. In the spring of 1793, having previously purchased a farm, containing 150 acres

of land, of Friend H. Frisbie, lying in the north-east corner of the town of Warren, in Milton Society, Litchfield County, Conn., he moved with his family to it, and engaged in farming, clearing land, and manufacturing charcoal for the use of the iron works, several of which were in operation near by. Here, pursuing "the even tenor of his ways," he passed the remainder of his life, honored and respected as an honest and upright man. He was a member of the Episcopal Church, and for several years one of its wardens. He took an active part in building a house of worship in Trinity Parish, Milton; he loved its services, and, although situated more than two miles from its place of worship, was very regular in his attendance upon them. Into the Episcopal Church all his children were baptized; by some one of its clergymen he and nearly all his children were married; and the solemn rites of its burial service were performed, when, on a cold, blustering day, February 2, 1822, his body was committed to its last resting place, the Rev. Isaac Jones officiating, who said, in his funeral discourse, that a pillar had been removed from the church militant.
