## Scope and Content Note

The papers of Lawrence Schlesinger Kubie (1896-1973) span the years 1916-1978 and consist of correspondence, memoranda, speeches and writings, reports, notes, financial and legal papers, family papers, printed material, photographs, and other material relating to Kubie's career in psychoanalysis.
