June 8th. 1760

DEAR SIR /

My friend Colo. Thomas Moore has applied to me, to assist him with a Sum of Money, to discharge a Debt due to You which he is very anxious of doing, and was it in my power at this time, I would readily advance the Sum he wants, but it really is not, if your Affairs would permit you to wait a little longer for it, I will engage to see you paid in Six Months.
