**FROM COLONEL GEORGE MUSE.**

GEO. MUSE 30th Novr. 1774

SIR

As there is a peace with the Indians shall be Obliged to you to have Deeds Executed for the land I Exchang'd wth. you as soon as conveniency will permit, in Order to have it saved, if you have an inclination to purchase please let me know by Mr Morton what you would give [mutilated] Acknowledge the receipt of 20£ by Colo. [mutilated] endleton for which I am Obliged to you, I Suppose Colo. Pendleton inform'd you that the deeds was Executed for the 80 Acres. from Sir yr. Most Hle. and Most Obedient Servt.
