**To JOSEPH JONES**

Yellow Springs, September 17, 1777.

Dear Sir: I have been favored with yours of the 14th. I do not wish to sell my phaeton, but shall be happy if you will take and use it 'till I shall have occasion for it. This I request you to do, as you will thereby accomodate yourself and serve me at the same time.<sup>1</sup>
