**To COLONEL DANIEL MORGAN**

Head Quarters, June 18, 1778.

Sir: As the Army is to march to morrow morning at 5 O'Clock, towards Coryells ferry, you are to cross the Schuylkill with your detachment and the horse annexed to it, at Matsons ford, and direct your course in such a manner as to intersect our line of march and fall in on our rear. I am & ca.<sup>1</sup>
