


Where Allies, Flushed With Victory, Were Advancing Just Before Armistice



THE ABOVE MAP SHOWS THE POSITION OF THE OPPOSING FORCES ON NOV. 4, 1918, SEVEN DAYS BEFORE THE ARMISTICE WAS SIGNED. IT ALSO INDICATES THE FURTHEST POINT REACHED BY THE GERMANS, THE FAMOUS HINDENBURG LINE, AND THE SUBORDINATE DEFENSE LINES THAT HAD BEEN OVERRUN IN PART OR WHOLLY BY THE ALLIES IN THEIR ADVANCE.
